

Ways to Save Money on Prescription Drugs when covered by a H.S.A.

- First place to start.....go GENERIC
- Ask the Pharmacy to run the prescription without Insurance, or what the “cash” price would be. If it ends up to be cheaper, you can then file a paper claim to get credit on your deductible.
- Check the Drug Formulary to make sure that your medication will be covered at the lowest Tier possible
- Ask your doctor if they have samples of Name Brand Drugs
- Using mail order may save money
- Ask a pharmacist for help. They can be a great resource for finding lower cost alternatives
- Comparison Shop. Drug costs can vary widely from one pharmacy to another
- When the medication is only available in ‘Name’ brand, go the manufacturer’s website. They offer Drug Savings Cards and/or Patient Assistance Programs
- Search drug savings websites such as www.goodrx.com, www.lowestmed.com, www.rxpricequotes.com. www.agelity.com, www.familywize.org * When using a savings coupon, the prescription cost is not applied to your Deductible; submit the amount on a Drug Claim Form
- Join Sam’s Club or Costco for extra Drug Savings; Check out any pharmacies that offer a Drug Savings Club or Generic List like Walmart, Walgreens, CVS, Kroger. KBA posts generic lists on our website
